

# Dress Code

Clay County School Policy 4.03 Pupil Dress states that all students shall be properly groomed and attired when on school property or participating in school activities. Students shall be dressed so they will not present a clean danger to health and safety; nor shall they be dressed in indecent or obscene attire; nor shall they be dressed in a manner which causes interference with work or creates classroom disruption or school disorder.

Parents are requested to supervise clothing selection and give guidance to acceptable school clothing choices. The general guidelines below list most violations of dress code. The final decision will be made by the administration.

1. Shoes must have either a back or back strap. (Shower shoes or flip flops are not permitted.)
2. Pants/shorts must fit at the waist. (Baggy pants included)
3. Halter tops, midriff tops, and mesh shirts are not allowed.
4. Shorts/skirts must be at least mid-thigh in length. (Short shorts and short mini-skirts are not permitted.)
5. Pierced ears are allowed, but no other body piercings will be permitted.
6. Baseball caps, hats, or bandannas are not permitted.
7. Shirts with suggestive decorations or obscene language will not be permitted.
8. Spaghetti strap dresses/tops can be worn when accompanied by a t-shirt.
9. Any type of tattoo, washable or not, is not allowed at Montclair Elementary.
10. Make-up is not permitted.

(Parents will be contacted to provide a change of clothes if student's dress is inappropriate.)
